1 Repsol Procurement Platform. SAP Ariba

Repsol Procurement Platform

SAP Ariba



Since July 2020, Repsol's Procurement processes have been managed from a new procurement platform based on the SAP Ariba cloud solution.

What is SAP Ariba?

SAP Ariba is a **cloud-based** platform that covers the **complete procurement process** (registration and qualification of suppliers, RFP, negocitations and awarding processes, auctions, contract and order management, good receipts and receipt of invoices).

It also allows interaction with the Supplier through the Ariba Network portal (https://supplier.ariba.com/)

The **change** to SAP Ariba has been made **gradually**:

- From May 2021 all supplier qualification and certificate management processes have been migrated to SAP Ariba.
- From September 2021 all tendering and awarding processes will be carried out from SAP Ariba (only those with an unexpired completion date will be managed in SRM).

Interaction between Repsol and the supplier is done through the collaborative portal, Ariba Network, where you must register to participate in our processes.

- If you already have an Ariba Network account, you will only need to complete your registration as a supplier with Repsol (even if you already have an account and work for other companies you need to complete your registration with Repsol).
- If you do not yet have an Ariba Network account, the first thing you must do is create your account on the portal and then complete your registration as a Repsol Supplier.

2 How to become a Repsol Supplier step by step

How to become a Repsol Supplier step by step



From now on, in order to participate in Repsol's Procurement processes, you must complete a series of steps to register in the Ariba Network (SAP Ariba collaboration portal) and also register as a supplier with Repsol.


This process can be initiated in two different ways:

- A Repsol Buyer initiates your registration process as a Supplier. You will then receive an email
 invitation to continue with the registration process.
- The Supplier, on its own initiative or at the indication of a Buyer, initiates the registration process. This process is called 'self-registration'. Once your self-registration request has been approved, you will receive an email invitation to continue with the registration process.

Supplier registration with Repsol step by step





1a Supplier Registration by Repsol Buyer



Once this step has been completed, you will receive an email invitation to complete your registration as a supplier with Repsol (see step 2).



1b Self-registration supplier request



As a supplier, you can, on your own initiative, initiate the registration process with Repsol by filling out a form.

To do so, you must access the Suppliers and Partners section of the Repsol website:

How to become a supplier for Repsol

If you have not had a prior business relationship with us and are interested in becoming part of our team as a supplier, you will first have to complete a pre-qualification questionnaire*. With this information, we will analyze whether you meet the minimum requirements to collaborate with us.

If information you provide is of interest to us, we will begin the qualification process, otherwise your request will be put on file to cover possible future needs.

By submitting this information, it does not imply in any case a commitment on behalf of REPSOL to contact the supplier and maintain any sort of professional relationship.


1b Self-registration supplier request



Once you have completed the questionnaire, the Repsol team will evaluate it and approve or reject your request:

- 1. If the request is approved, you will receive an email invitation to complete your registration as a Repsol Supplier (see step 2).
- 2. If the request is rejected, you will receive an email informing you of Repsol's decision.

2 Invitation to register as a Supplier with Repsol



Whether a Repsol Buyer initiates your registration process or you decide to send a self-registration request on your own initiative, you will receive an e-mail inviting you to register with Repsol.

(In the case of a self-registration request, you will only receive it when your request is approved by Repsol's internal team).

Regardless of whether you already have an Ariba Network account or not, select "Click here".

- It is important that you check your email (including your spam folder) to verify that you have received the email.
- This link is for one-time use only, do not leave the process until you have completed it. If the link has expired you can create your account or log in directly from https://supplier.ariba.com/.

Repsol - TEST

Register as a supplier with Repsol - TEST

Hello!

Repsol - TEST has invited you to register to become a supplier with Repsol - TEST. Start by creating an account with Ariba Network. It's free.

It is mandatory to have an account in the Ariba Network and to have completed the "Registration" questionnaire ("registered" status) in order to participate and be awarded the Repsol - TEST tenders.

Repsol - TEST uses Ariba Network to manage its sourcing and procurement activities and to collaborate with suppliers. If prueba test already has an account with Ariba Network, sign in with your username and password.

Click Here to create account now.

Please, it is necessary to complete the registration process without leaving the link that contains the self-registration email as it is for single use, in this way the process can be completed correctly. Once the process is complete in Ariba, you will access the Repsol - TEST record, which you will have 30 days to complete.



Depending on whether you already have a user on the Ariba Network or not, you must click on the corresponding option:





3 Ariba Network account



Remember that Ariba Network is the Repsol-Supplier collaboration portal and you must register with it in order to complete your registration as a supplier and participate in our procurement process, qualification and certificate/questionnaire management processes.

You can create your Ariba Network account from two different points. Log in and complete the form:

From email invitation (see step2)







Once you have managed your registration in Ariba Network you need to log in to complete your registration as a Repsol Supplier.

You can access the registration form in two ways:

From email invitation (see step2)




From Ariba Network (see step 3 if you don't have an Ariba Network account)






Access the questionnaire and fill in the required information in the different sections:



Once complete, click on the **Submit Entire Response option**.



You will be able to see the **status of your request** in the "Proposals and questionnaires" tab in the "Registration questionnaires" section under "**Status**".



Once the **request is approved**, the status will be updated to **Approved**, which completes the registration process at Repsol.





1. Participation in negotiation processes




2. Qualification processes


During the **qualification process** you will receive a **qualification questionnaire** to complete. This questionnaire **will be reviewed and approved by various teams**, and if successfully completed, you will be **qualified**.



3. Questionnaires & certificates

Repsol may request certain information from you through questionnaires and certificates that will be managed through the Ariba Network.

These questionnaires and certificates may be required during the tendering and qualification processes depending on the requirements and data of the Supplier.

- Types of questionnaires: Data protection, compliance...
- Types of certificates: Environment Certificate: ISO 14001, Safety OHSAS 18001 & ISO 45001, Automation Quality IATF 16949, Quality ISO 9001, ...

Depending on the type of questionnaire/certificate you will be required to answer certain questions or attach certain documentation. Once submitted, they will be reviewed internally by Repsol and their status can be tracked directly on the Ariba Network.


First they will ask you a series of questions to try to classify the problem you have and give you a solution to it.

For example, let's say you have a problem creating your Ariba Network account. Select the checked option:






You will be presented with a series of possible problems, select the one that most closely matches your error.
